- Automated Data Collection
 - Download from USPTO into IP tools
 - E-mails from Trademark Office

- Docketing automatically processed into docket system
- Items are reported to attorneys/paralegals
- Items are automatically reported to clients



- Docketing automatically processed into docket system
- Items are reported to attorneys/paralegals
- Items are automatically reported to client
- Items filed in patent center
- PAIR copy of filed items downloaded
- PAIR copy sent to IP tools
- Filed items automatically processed into docket system
- Filed items are automatically reported to clients



- Some items cannot be automatically reported
- These are treated as exceptions and manually completed
- Items are still queued for reporting, but wait for additional documents to be attached




- Any additional documents downloaded (e.g., Trademark documents)
- PDF's and metadata from USPTO are OCR'd
- PAIR xml is obtained
- Key information is extracted from image
- Documents are identified
- Context is analyzed
- Proper action for context is determined



- Parameters needed for IP system are retrieved
- IP system state is determined
- Action and system state are compared
- Docket is updated automatically
- Docket data is downloaded
- Verification rule set is executed to verify correct action taken

Example of handling office nonfinal office actions


- Office Action automatically processed into docket system
 - Software Downloads document
 - Software Identifies the document and determines what to docket
 - Software Loads docketing data into Docketing System with an API connection
 - Software verifies the docketing
- All without a person logging in to PAIR or the docketing system!



- Identified document and parts are sent to reporting system
- Reporting system determines reporting rules and templates for client
- Items are reported using template



- Automated Message (24hours after receipt):
 "Final/Non-Final Office Action Received For Matter # XXX.XXXXX"
 - i. "We received an Office Action for the below mentioned matter(s). Please let me know if you would like assistance in scheduling an examiner interview."
 - ii. Client, Matter, Serial No., Action, Due Date, Working Attorney
- Tasks Added Message (daily)
- i. TASKS DUE TODAY
 "Matter Action Working Attorney Title Client Status "(same for below)
- i. TASKS DUE TOMORROW
- ii. TASKS ADDED TODAY
- iii. TASKS DUE IN TWO WEEKS



After Receipt and Reporting to Client:

- Office Actions and prior art are loaded into ClaimTracker
- ClaimTracker tracks all rejections and claim amendments


Response shell is merged from ClaimTracker with current set of claims and shell of rejection from USPTO




